



Success With Apples



- Plant at least two different compatible varieties for maximum fruit yield and quality. (See our [Apple Pollination Guide](#) for compatible varieties).
- We sell semi-dwarf trees which reach 12-15 feet in height at maturity. They are easier to manage and produce fruits earlier than standard-size trees.
- Space trees 12-15 feet apart in the row, with 15-20 feet between rows.
- Plant fruit trees in full sun in organically rich soil that drains well. Apples prefer slightly acidic soil. Avoid wet areas or areas with very sandy, shallow soil.
- Avoid planting in typical frost pockets where late cold snaps could harm apple blossoms.
